


Prague

Prague, the City of a Hundred Spires, a UNESCO monument and one of the most beautiful cities in the world. Experience it in person! Staying in Prague, at the heart of Europe, gives you the best location to travel to other Czech and European destinations. Included in the Summer School are trips around Czech Republic and abroad. Summer School students will enjoy the sights of Český Krumlov, magnificent Kutná Hora and Karlštejn castle. The students will also experience the allure of Vienna, Austria's capital city. All trips are expertly supervised by our dedicated VSFS staff.

Kutná Hora

A popular day trip destination from Prague, Kutná Hora offers spectacular faded grandeur without the capital's madding crowds. Wenceslas II's Royal Mint established there in 14th century turned the town into financial center of Bohemia. Powerful enough to rival Prague's magnificence, Kutna Hora flourished until the silver ore ran out. The town was added to UNESCO's World Heritage list in 1996. Saint Barbara's cathedral and the eerie Kostnice bone church, decorated with disconcerting sculptures of the bones of plague victims, are today's main attractions of the town.





Český Krumlov

The southwestern castle city of Český Krumlov is one of the Czech Republic's finest medieval sites. Its Old Town is a UNESCO-designated World Heritage Site, a maze of twisting alleys built around the extensive Český Krumlov castle. Saunter through crooked, cobblestone streets on foot and soak up the atmosphere of this impeccably preserved medieval gem. The gushing Vltava, popular with rafting enthusiasts, darts through the town.

Karlštejn

Nestled in the Czech countryside, Karlštejn is like a medieval masterpiece, full of old charm and stories. The castle stands tall, watching over a town that's like a living history book. Walking through the cobblestone street up to the castle, you can feel the history in every step. Karlštejn, surrounded by beautiful landscapes, quietly shares its stories, making you reflect on the simple beauty of the past.





Vienna

Students will go on a 5 day trip to capital of Austria where they will stay in shared rooms (bunks) in a hostel located right at the centre of the city. Vienna, also described as Europe's cultural capital, is a metropolis with unique charm, vibrancy and flair. Every year, millions of visitors are attracted by its imperial architecture, museums, parks, classical music and its famous coffee house culture.



Company Visits

Students will have unique opportunity to visit national institutions such as the heart of Czech finance and economy - Central Bank, as well as world-famous international companies. Among the residing in the Czech capital companies are Coca Cola, Skoda, Microsoft, KPMG, Staropramen, Pilsner Urquell, Huawei, PwC and many others. Company visits are supervised by VSFS staff and the company representatives.
